I hope that everyone had a great weekend! It is hard to believe that we have already completed the first quarter of school. We still have a lot to accomplish this year. Please encourage your child to work hard and do their best! I have some new things that I am going to try to boost our reading and math skills this quarter.

In addition to the math homework, I will be sending home reading and multiplication practice each night. On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday the students will be reading to an adult for at least 20 minutes. Then, on Tuesday and Thursday, they will practice multiplication flash cards with an adult for at 20 minutes. They will be bringing home a slip each night that must be signed by a parent or guardian saying that they practiced/read with them.

I have attached the reading and grammar newsletter for this week. It includes the weekly story summary, comprehension skill, grammar skill, spelling words, and vocabulary words. Discussing this page with your child will reinforce the concepts that we are learning in class.
